

Coleshill Parish Council  
Magpie Lane Speed Reduction  
Funding Request



Dear Resident,

As you know for some years Coleshill Parish Council has been campaigning to reduce the speed limit on Magpie Lane from 40mph to 30mph to improve road safety, and 334 people responded positively to the idea when surveyed. There are no pavements, 5 footpaths cross the lane, and it is used by large numbers of cyclists and pedestrians. Bucks Council Highways have finally agreed to do this!

The statutory and ancillary costs of making this change is £16,000. In an ideal world this would be fully funded but Bucks have told us they are only able to fund 25%, which leaves a shortfall of £12,000, which the Parish Council needs to find. Unfortunately, we don't have the money.

We are therefore asking for pledges of support to meet this cost for the benefit of villagers and visitors. If we cannot raise the funds the speed limit will remain at 40mph for years to come.
